Regenerative Farming Techniques

Lessons learnt from the Mulloon Creek project

Based on the Natural Sequence Farming concepts of Peter Andrews, works began in 2006 at a property near Braidwood to slow the creek's flow, raise its water level, de-energise flood waters and reinvigorate the floodplain.

Ten years on and much has changed. The creek is now a healthy, vibrant ecosystem, filtering water through its extensive reed beds, capturing flood sediments, recycling nutrients and providing complex habitat for birds, mammals, reptiles, frogs, fish and invertebrates. And the floodplain through which the creek flows is now 60% more productive.

So successful was the original demonstration that landowners along the Creek have come together to participate in a major extension of the project. Enter, the Mulloon Community Landscape Rehydration Project.
