

Re-greening the Riverina Highlands is a 1 year project which aims to protect & enhance the natural assets of the Snowy Valleys Shire. This revegetation program forms part of the project by establishing native vegetation on key properties in the Shire.

Aim of the Project:

This project has been developed to support landholders in addressing land management issues. In doing so the project will connect areas of native vegetation, reduce soil erosion and improve the health of local waterways.

What Funding is Available:

Up to \$6,000 (GST excl) per property is available for:

- Fencing—materials towards a stock proof fence.
- 2. Site Preparation for tree planting
- Revegetation—cost of locally grown native tubestock and tree guards (if required). Note corridor sites must be a minimum of 20m wide.

Please note that limited funding is available and each site will be assessed & ranked against suitability criteria.

Who is involved in the Project:

This project is a partnership between the Riverina Highlands Landcare Network & Snowy Valleys Shire.

Timing:

Landholders will need to submit an Expression of Interest before the 1st March 2017 with on grounds works to be completed by the 30th June 2017.

How to Apply:

The Riverina Highlands Landcare Network invites land managers to express interest in undertaking works to address land management Issues. A copy of the Expression of Interest form can be found overleaf.

Priority will be given to sites which are easily accessible to enable a community or school group to assist with the planting. All applicants will be advised of the result of their application.







Re-greening The Riverina Highlands

Community Revegetation Project

Project Requirements:

To be eligible for the Re-greening The Riverina Highlands Project, you will need to consider the following criteria:

- Your property is within the boundaries of the Riverina Highlands Landcare Network and the Snowy Valleys Shires (ie the former Tumut Shire).
- You are a member of the Riverina Highlands Landcare Network. For a copy of the membership slip please visit http://www.riverinahighlandslandcare.com.au
- You are prepared to erect and maintain fencing which will be an average of 15m from the gully edge or 20m wide for corridor sites and plant the site with a mixture of native trees and shrubs
- You are prepared to enter into a 10 year agreement which will detail the works required and your responsibilities to manage the site for 10 years.
- You have no agreements or have not received previous government funding for your proposed project area.
- You can complete the on ground works by the 30th July 2017.
- Priority will be given to proposals with sites which are easily accessible to enable a community or school group to assist with the planting.
